'AFTER THE MASTERS' SHOTS



ALONG THE MOLONGLO

The 8<sup>th</sup> Along the Molonglo Art Exhibition and Competition  
*'The Secrets of the Molonglo, its Haunts, Habitats and Homes'*



THE Queanbeyan Art Society and the Molonglo Catchment Group are once again celebrating the Molonglo catchment, its natural values and its people through art. This year, the Queanbeyan community is celebrating the release of its revised Queanbeyan River Corridor Management Plan and a new Platypus (and native water rat) Conservation Strategy, so the Exhibition is focusing on the aquatic habitat of animals and birds. This theme for 2012 will capture some of the many and changing moods of the aquatic environment of the Molonglo River, its tributaries, creeks, wetlands and urban lakes that are now healthy with restored flows after excellent rains. The Exhibition will be opened by one of the dedicated scientists working with the Australian Platypus Conservancy. The Conservancy has greatly assisted us to prepare the Platypus Awareness and Conservation Strategy for the Queanbeyan River.

Also along this theme, on **World Environment Day Tuesday 5 June**, a public Forum will be held at 6pm at the Community meeting Rooms in Crawford Street, to raise public awareness about two of our very special animals, the platypus and the native water rat and to recruit members of the community in monitoring these animals.

**Melody Serena** from the Australian Platypus Conservancy will be giving this talk. Melody is already familiar with Queanbeyan River habitat. Enquiries can be directed to Tom Baker at 62974920.

The Molonglo Catchment Group is also revising its Molonglo Catchment Strategy and more details can be obtained by going to the website [molonglocatchment.org.au](http://molonglocatchment.org.au) or calling Anna See the Catchment Coordinator on 62992119.

**Geoff Williams** helped to establish the Australian Platypus Conservancy in 1994.

He has since conducted more than 450 all-night platypus trapping surveys and been involved in various special studies of platypus and also Australian water-rats.

Prior to his work with the APC, Geoff was Director of Healesville Sanctuary for five years from 1988 to 1993 and, before moving to Victoria, was Assistant Director of Sydney's Taronga Zoo from 1985 to 1988.

Geoff has presented numerous public talks on platypus and water-rats at venues throughout Australia, including the National Museum in Canberra and the Melbourne Museum (on behalf of Australian Geographic).

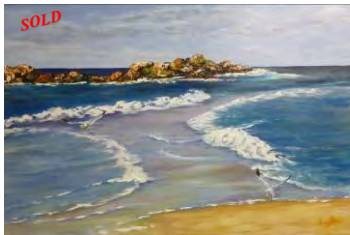

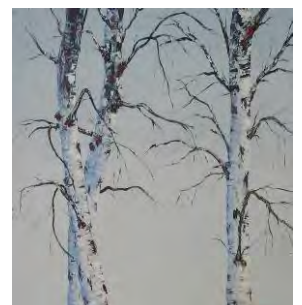

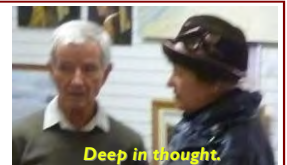
