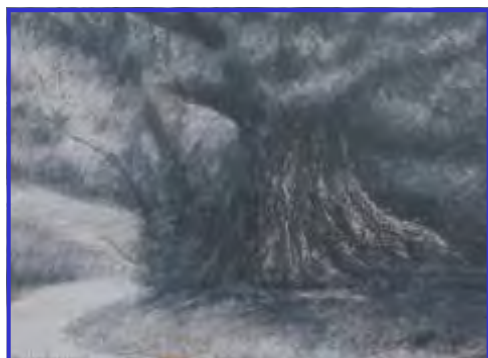

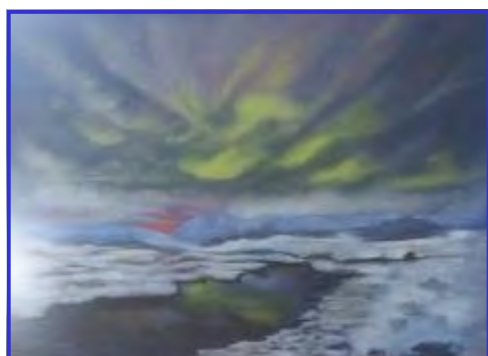

PORTRAIT WORKSHOP WITH JULIE BALLIS

Julie Ballis has 25 years of instructing portraiture – what a wonderful achievement. Julie was delighted to have Camelia Smith, one of her models 15 years ago, as a participant in this Sept workshop. Ably assisted by her husband Geoff, Julie provided an elevated theatrical setting to enhance the subjects: Graham Adler, violinist, in top hat, tails and bright bow tie; and Julie’s daughter Renee, her long blonde hair topped by an elegant flowing hat – both excellent models. Julie began by explaining the importance of the initial drawing up of the subject, ensuring it fits comfortably within the canvas. She continued to demonstrate how to measure facial features in relation to each other, tonal values and colour mixing. Students received caring and thoughtful tuition. They expressed their appreciation of Julie’s generous and broad ranging knowledge which was delivered in a fun and enjoyable environment. One comment was that “I have learned a lot and by practising I hope to retain the knowledge gained.” In conjunction with artist quality oil paints, Julie uses Turpenoid to clean brushes and Liquin as the medium, ensuring low or no odour. Others who have issues with oils and associated fumes might find these products very useful. There were no fumes in the gallery at this workshop. The morning and afternoon tea supplied by Belinda and Pam was well received and many took the opportunity to enjoy lunch from the Riverside Café. A most enjoyable weekend was had by all. Good company and friendship. What more could one wish for.

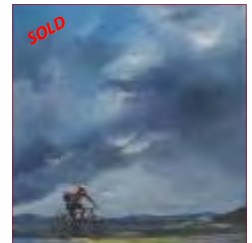
